Rules/Regulations:

Although this race will not be a regulation derby race, to insure maximum safety and enjoyment the following rules WILL be enforced. Each car entered into the race MUST be a four-wheel car. Cars with less than 4 wheels will be disqualified upon check-in. ALL cars must be equipped with an adequate braking system AND steering system to insure maximum driver and spectator safety. ALL drivers will be **required** to wear a helmet, elbow & knee pads, shoes (no open toe) and protective eyewear. ALL cars will be inspected upon check-in on race day. A "pit area" will be designated for each age category. Racecar numbers will be assigned upon registration. An informational meeting will be set for parents & drivers.
