The new Andy ReStore has opened at 44 Strawberry Ave. in Lewiston.

Androscoggin Habitat for Humanity owns the store and volunteers operate it. There are no fancy fixtures or displays — just stacks of doors, windows and roofing materials, and an area filled with kitchen cupboards and counters and other items.

The goods have been donated by contractors, building supply firms, and people who have things left over from house-remodeling projects. The money earned helps build affordable homes for families who need a helping hand.

The Andy ReStore is open Tuesday to Saturday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.



Donations we can accept . . .

— Appliances: Must be in safe working order and not more than 10 years old. No old personal computers or monitors will be accepted.

— Windows: No broken glass, or single-layer units.

— Lumber: Must be straight and not less than 8 feet long.

— Cabinets: Bathroom and kitchen cabinets and countertops are welcome. They must be in working condition, including hardware.

— Furniture: Tables, chairs, dressers, drawer chests, bureaus, book shelving, bedsteads or frames are welcome. They must be in usable condition. No upholstered furniture, no bedding and no mattresses.

— Plumbing: Baths, basins, sinks and accessories, fittings, faucets, sink, shower and bath fittings, towel rails and rings, pipe fittings, and copper, pex and polyvinyl tubing, schedule 40 PVC pipe and fittings are welcome. (Pipe lengths not less than 4 feet).

— Roofing: shingles, vents, gutters, downpipes and accessories

— Siding: vinyl, trim, soffit material (full-length material only).

— Tools: power drills and tools, cordless tools, hand tools.

— Architectural items: columns, fireplaces, mantelpieces, antiques, etc.

— Wall board: nothing smaller than 4'X4', and in useable condition.

— Building materials: 4x8 sheeting/plywood for flooring (3/4"), walls (1/2") and roofs (5/8").

— Electrical: light fixtures, electrical fittings, power panels, circuit breakers, receptacles, wall boxes, 12- and 14-gauge wiring (minimum 25-foot lengths), ceiling and wall fans.

— Interior, exterior and storm doors.

— Insulation (fiberglass, cellulose, polystyrene).
